Coach of the Year Award	<p>This prestigious award looks to recognise volunteer coaches in our county for their time and commitment which influences others to become involved, develop and improve along the sporting pathway.</p> <p>What we're looking for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coach qualifications and time commitment • The progress and achievement of performer / teams being coached • Evidence of working within the community • Evidence of the impact the coach has had on widening access to sport through coaching • Evidence of the wider impact the coach has on the participants / performers they coach (such as personal development, health and wellbeing and educational attainment). <p><i>This category is restricted to volunteers only.</i></p> <p><i>Nominations must come from a representative of an official sporting body, club, organisation or school.</i></p> <p><i>Nominees must reside within Ceredigion or be a member of a school, club or organisation within its boundaries</i></p>
Unsung Hero Award	<p>This award is for an individual who has devoted their time to developing sport in Ceredigion within a community setting over a number of years.</p> <p>What we're looking for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A lifetime's dedication to improving sport in any sporting situation – from coaching, officiating and administration to washing the kit, driving the team bus, preparing refreshments or even organising ground maintenance. • They have been instrumental in recruiting other people to help out in sport to enable the club or sporting organisation to grow. • Acting as role models and encouraging others to do sport. • Examples of programmes or legacies which have enabled the sports, organisations, club's work to be continued. • Evidence of the wider impact the contribution has on the

<p>Disability Sport Volunteer of the Year Award</p>	<p>They give up their time to lead, inspire and support more disabled people to participate in sport – by officiating at matches, running events, undertaking administrative, coaching, organising or acting in support roles in national organisations / community disability sport clubs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acting as role models and encouraging others to do sport. • These individuals lead by example, encouraging inclusion, being innovative in their practise, getting things done. • Evidence of the wider impact on participants (such as personal development, health and wellbeing and educational attainment). • Evidence of the impact the individual has had on widening access to sport for disabled people • Evidence of providing opportunities and/or dedicated support within a mainstream sporting environment or a dedicated disability sport environment <p><i>This category is restricted to volunteers only.</i></p> <p><i>Nominations must come from a Representative of an official sporting body, club, organisation or school.</i></p> <p><i>Nominees must reside within Ceredigion or be a member of a school, club or organisation within its boundaries</i></p>
<p>5x60 Volunteer of the Year Award</p>	<p>The Award will be made to the person who, in the opinion of the selection panel, has made an outstanding contribution to 5x60 and AYP programmes as a volunteer in a school or community club in Ceredigion during the academic year 2016-17. The panel will be looking for a person who has shown commitment to promoting 5x60 & AYP activities to children and recruiting and/or mentoring parents and volunteers. The Nominee will also have promoted Fair Play within the activities undertaken.</p>

<p>Bronze Young Ambassador of the Year Award</p>	<p>The Award will be made to the Bronze Young Ambassador/s, in the opinion of the selection panel, has made an outstanding contribution to the AYP programmes as a Young Ambassador in a PRIMARY school in Ceredigion during the academic year 2016-17. They must be able to demonstrate their commitment to the sport/school/club. The panel will be looking for a Bronze Young Ambassador who has consistently delivered lunchtime clubs and promoted sport and wellbeing within their school.</p> <p><i>This category is restricted to Bronze Young Ambassadors only. Nominations must come from school staff. Schools may nominate individual/pairs of Bronze Young Ambassadors.</i></p> <p><i>Nominees must be a current Bronze Young Ambassador in a Ceredigion County Council Primary School.</i></p>
<p>Young Ambassador of the Year Award</p>	<p>The Award will be made to the Silver or Gold Young Ambassador who, in the opinion of the selection panel, has made an outstanding contribution to 5x60 & AYP programmes as in a secondary school or community club in Ceredigion during the academic year 2016-17. The panel will be looking for a Young Ambassador who has shown commitment to promoting the 5x60 & AYP programme to children and recruiting and/or mentoring parents and volunteers. The Nominee will also have promoted Fair Play within the activities undertaken.</p> <p><i>This category is restricted to Silver & Gold Young Ambassadors only. Nominations must come from a Representative of an official sporting body, club, organisation or school.</i></p> <p><i>Nominees must be a current Silver/Gold Young Ambassador in a Ceredigion County Council Secondary School.</i></p>
